

Emerging Fellowship



Eligibility Requirements

Apply if you:

- Will be enrolled as a full-time student at a four-year institution for at least two more terms after next summer;*
- Have identified a policy problem you'd like to help solve;

And you can:

- Commit five hrs/week virtually from next June to the following May and
- Attend a four-day, in-person conference at beginning of August (Roosevelt will pay for travel and lodging)

***Unfortunately, international and undocumented students are not eligible for Network fellowships**
