

Forge Fellowship

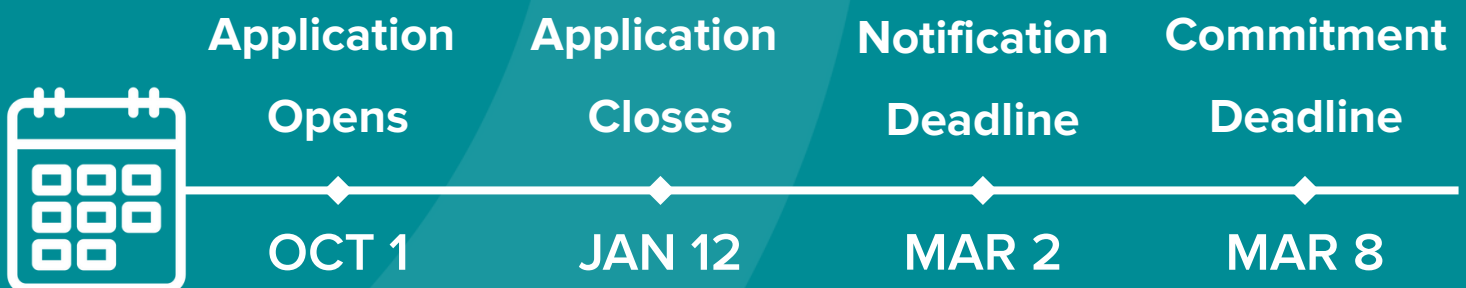

Eligibility Requirements

Apply if you are:

- A first-year student at a four-year institution;*
- A community college student with plans to eventually transfer to a four-year institution; or
- A college-bound high school senior.

And you can:

- Commit five hrs/week virtually from next June to next December; and
- Attend a four-day, in-person conference at beginning of August (Roosevelt will pay for travel and lodging)

***Full-time students must also be a U.S. citizen, Permanent Resident, or DACA recipient**

Other eligibility criteria and program participation requirements may apply
