Remote, 5 hrs/week**June–July 2026**
In-person, Monday–Friday

Will be enrolled as a full-time student at a four-year institution for at least one more term after next summer

Emerging Fellowship

- Author a policy brief published by Roosevelt
- Good preparation for grad school/employment

**\$3000 Stipend****June 2026–May 2027**
5 hrs/week**Fully Remote**
